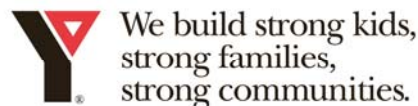

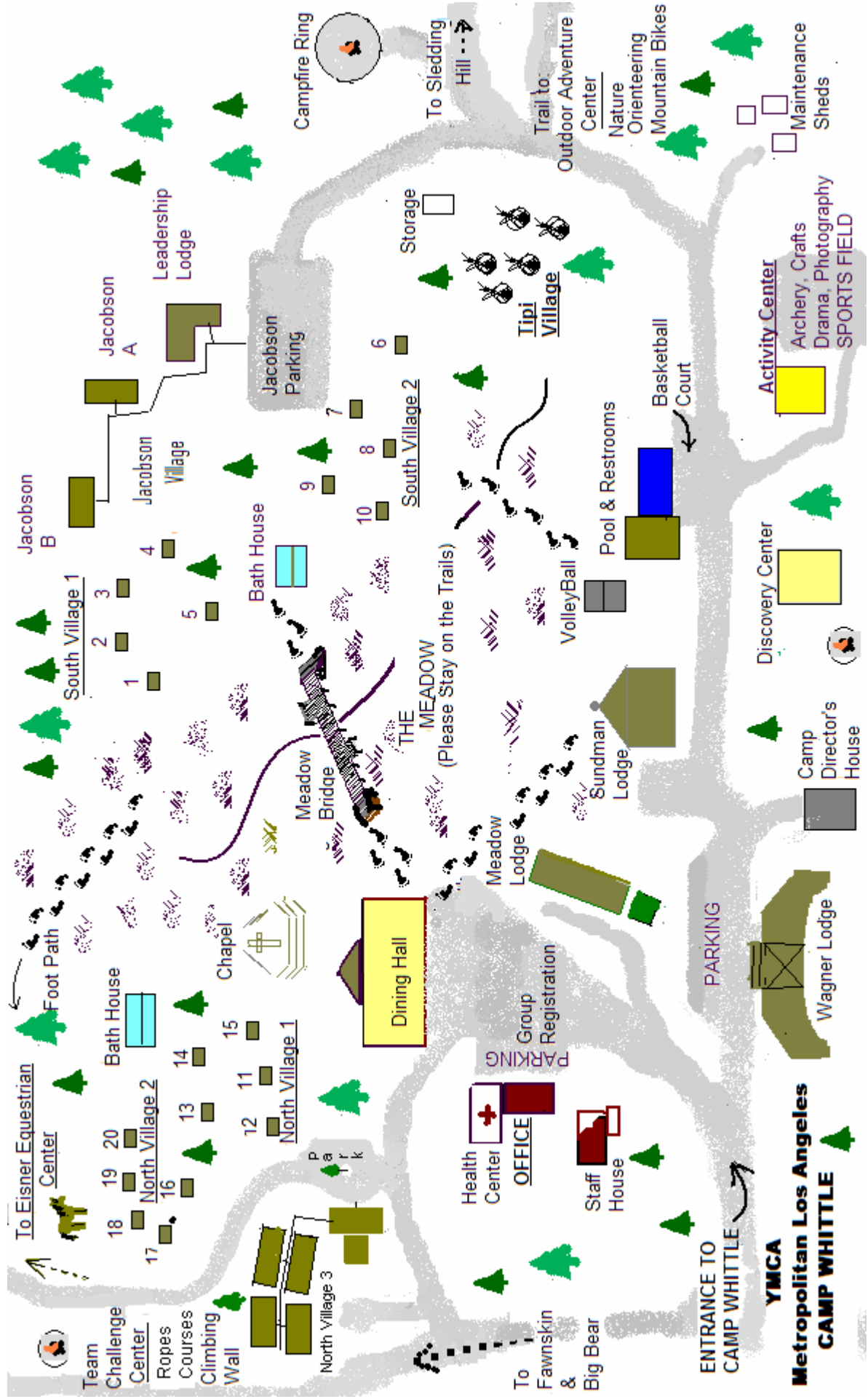

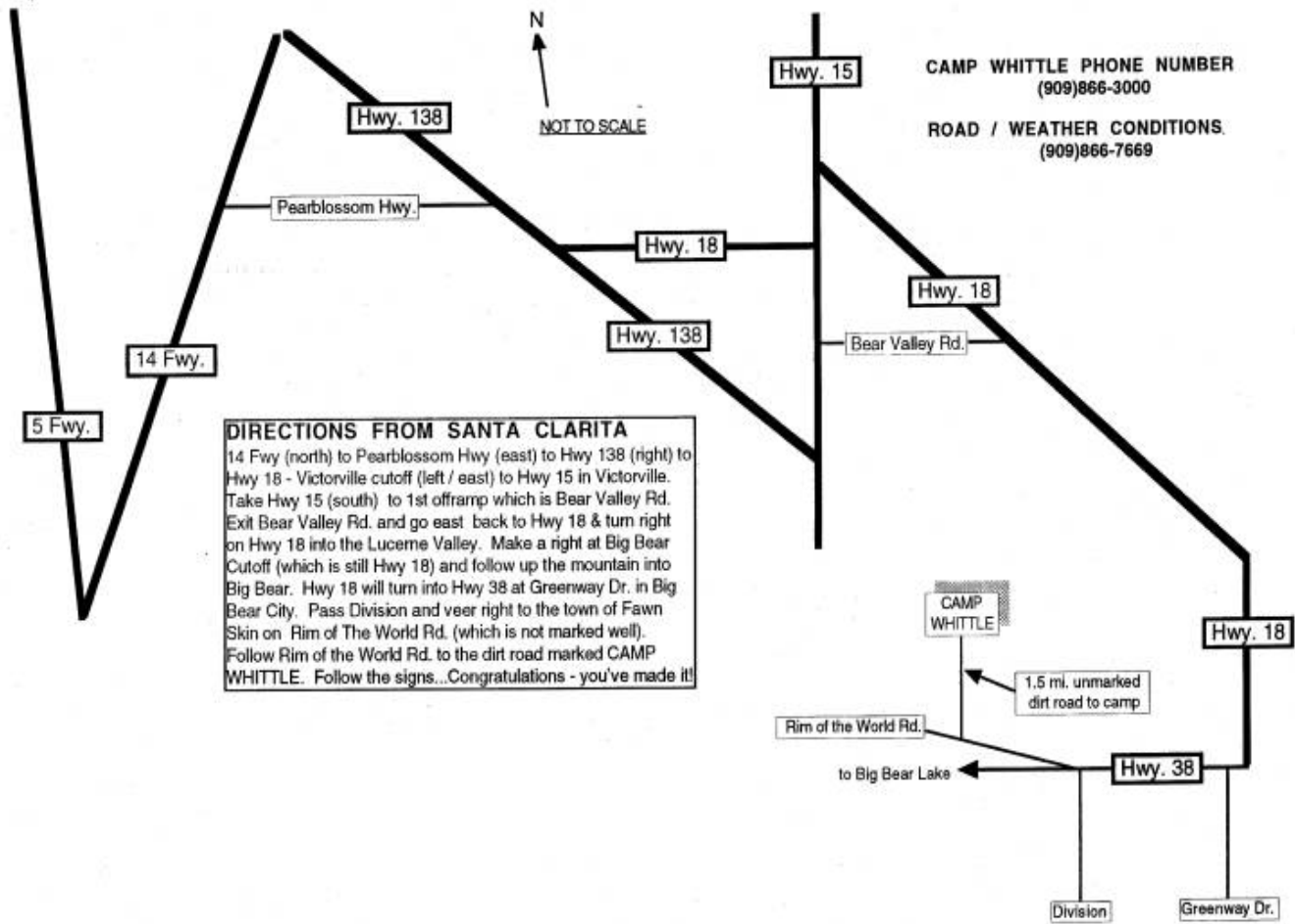

# Preferred Route:

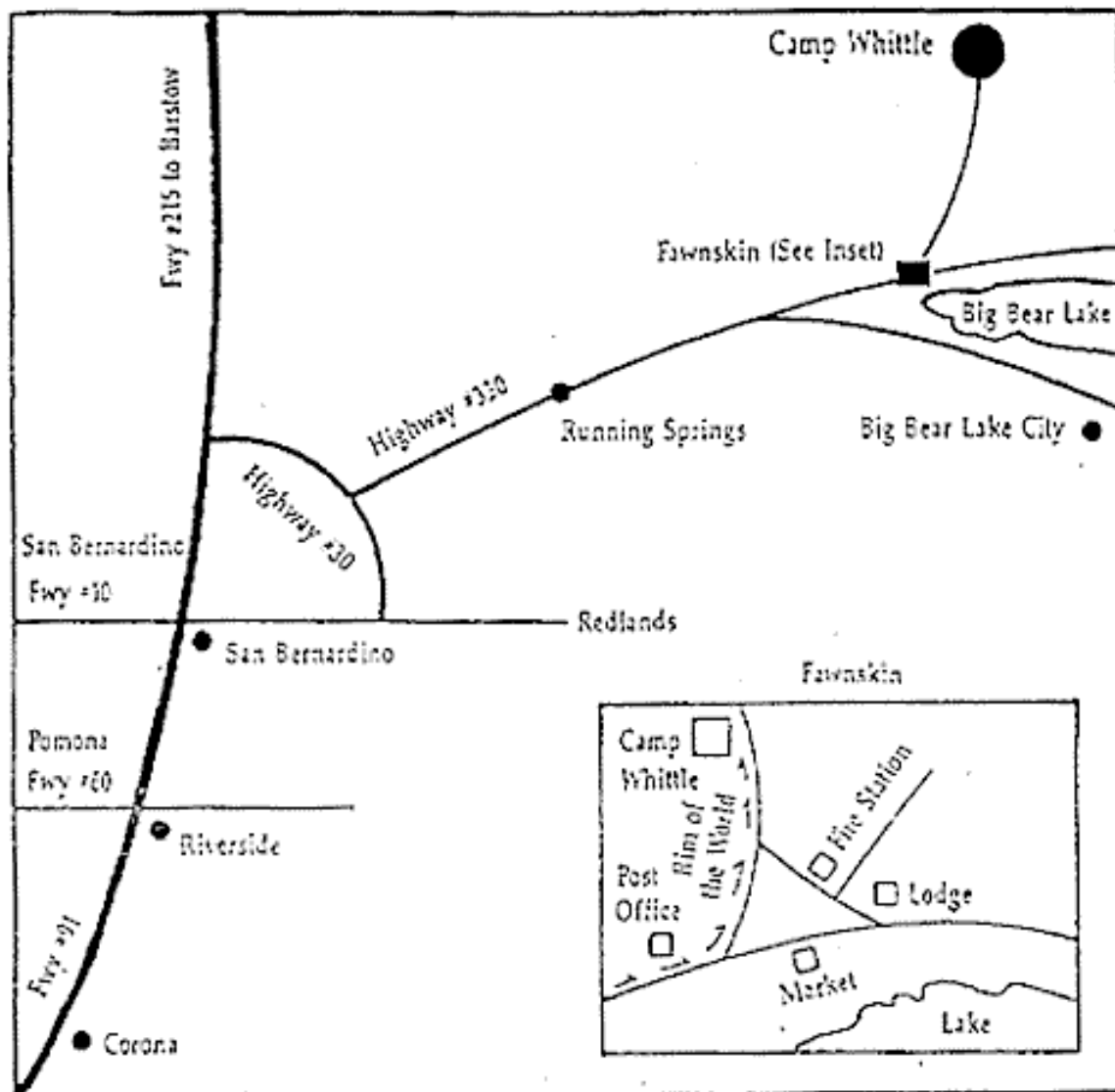
## THE BACK WAY TO CAMP WHITTLE

(APPROXIMATELY 2 1/2 HOUR DRIVE)



## Front Way to Camp Whittle:

### CAMP HAROLD F. WHITTLE WAGNER LODGE & CONFERENCE CENTER



Located approximately 120 miles from Los Angeles, allow 3 hours of driving time. Use the best freeway heading east out of the Los Angeles area to the San Bernardino area. About 5 miles from the #10 and the #215 Freeway Interchange will be the Highway #30, "Mountain Resort", exit. Follow the signs to the Highway #330, exit to Big Bear Lake.

On Highway #330 continue through Running Springs to Big Bear Lake. DO NOT CROSS THE DAM. Stay on the North Shore Drive to the town of Fawnskin. Turn left on Rim of the World Drive and drive about 2 miles to the camp. A short distance from Fawnskin the paved road ends into a well graded dirt road, (US Forest Service road 3N14). Follow the signs to YMCA Camp Whittle which will be located on your left.
